

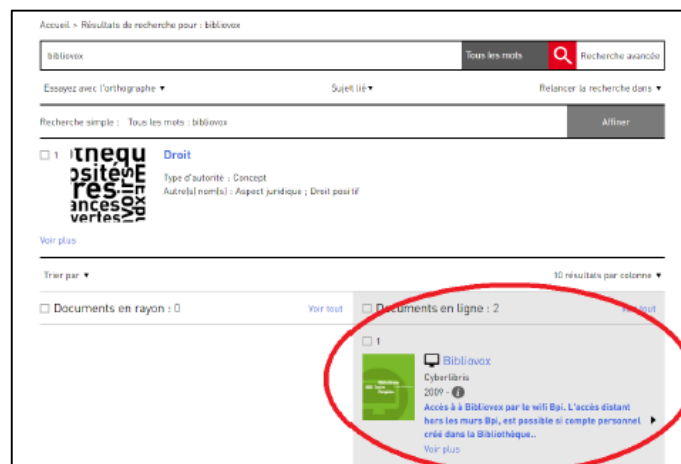


# How to get remote access to Bibliovox ?

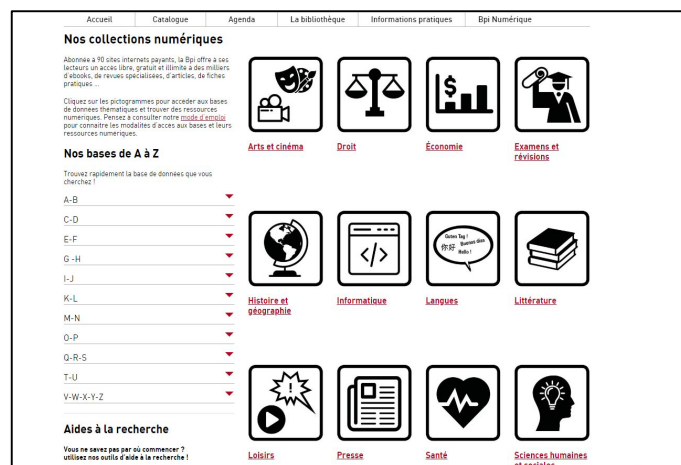
Would you like to read thousands of e-books from your sofa ? Just follow the instructions !

## Let's meet at the Bpi !

Connect to wifi.bpi from you tablet, smartphone, laptop, or try one of the computer at the library. Type "Bibliovox" in the catalogue.

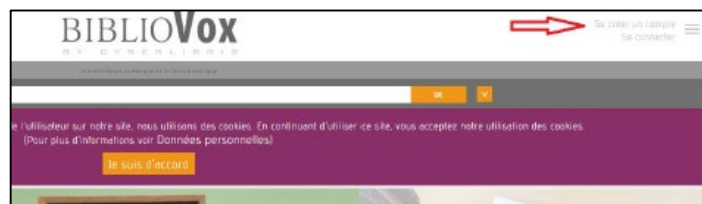


**OR** go to the "Bpi at home" section in "Digital Bpi" tab.



## 2. Create an account


On the homepage, click on "signup" at the top right.:


## 2. Create an account (2)

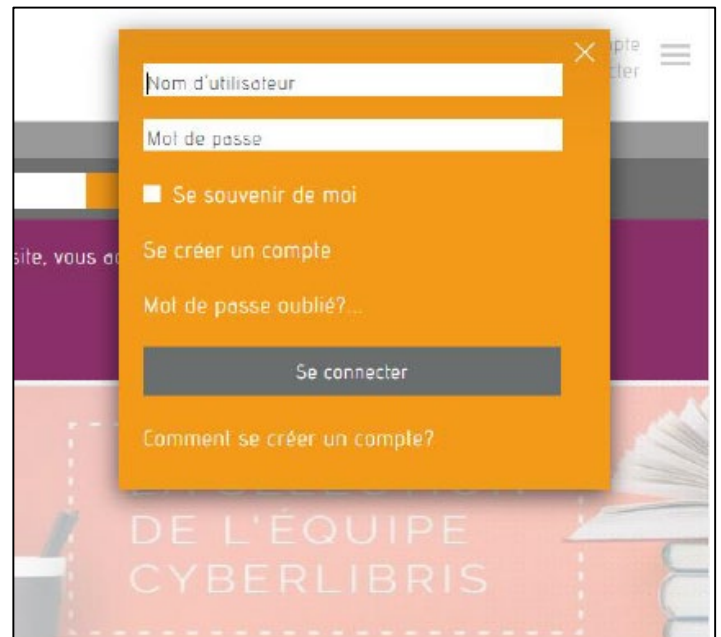
## 4. 24/7 Access

Go to Bibliobox, directly through your search engine.

On the home page, click on “sign up” (at the top right).



Use your email as username and fill in with your password. Then, click on “Log in”.
